

Meridian H.S. Class of 2020 Graduation Instructions

Planning -

Please arrive 5-10 minutes before your scheduled time dressed in your cap and gown.

You will move through a series of stations that will comply with social distancing expectations.

Drivers – by following the car in front of you, you will be able to view your graduate walk across the stage during station #7.

We are under a tight schedule and recording the entire time. With that in mind we ask that you



- Stay in your car
- Do not honk your horns or make loud noises (this is being recorded)
- Keep moving as the car in front of you moves. By not continuing forward, you risk another family missing their student walk across the stage.

Students – if no one can drive you to campus and you must drive yourself, please park in the spaces closest to the church in the parking lot and walk to station #1.

Arrival -

Please come to the east parking lot (between MHS and the church) and go around the parking lot until you get to the marked drop off location. At this point you need to **put on your mask** and get out of your vehicle.

Station #1 – Wait outside on the pre-marked locations keeping six feet apart from other graduates. You will move forward as the person in front of you moves forward.

BE SURE STAY IN THE ORDER YOU WERE DROPPED OFF

Station #2 – Enter the building and go straight to the gym. Jostens will be there to make sure you have what you need. A staff member will be there if you are having some trouble with your cap.

Station #3 – When station #3 opens, proceed to the west side of the gym and have your picture taken.

Station #4 – When station #4 opens, proceed down the hall to just outside the double doors. There you will pick up your name card and Futures Card (if you filled one out). If not the staff member will write a quick sentence about your plans in the fall to be used as your Futures Card.

Station #5 – When station #5 opens, proceed to the marked pillar. There you will be met by a staff member who will take your name card and Futures Card.

Station #6 – When the student in front of you has gone to the stage stairs you can move forward to station #6 and you can remove your mask. Please wait for the staff member to tell you when to move to the stage stairs.

Station #7 — Wait at the bottom of the stage for your name to be read. When it is read walk up the stairs and onto the stage. Pick up your diploma and then stop at the pre-marked spot. Stop for a photo. You will then continue down the stairs when instructed.

Station #8 – After leaving the stage, put your mask back on and walk to the stop sign. Your ride will be there to pick you up and you will need to then depart from the bus loop.
