- A chance to complete a failed course or teacher assigned incomplete through APEX Learning
- One or more courses available.
- As soon as course is successfully completed, students can receive high school credit.

HOW?

- Students can work at own pace until course is completed. Classes include both computer and written work.
- Once classes are complete the student does not need to continue attending.
- Certified teacher available assist and answer questions.

WHY?

- Students to gain credit for courses incomplete or failed during previous school years.
- Get back on track to graduate.
